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Ela Spalding (Panama/UK, 1982) is an artist~facilitator exploring the ecotones between fields of knowledge, using art as a conduit to practice and convey our interconnectedness with all of life. Her practice lies at the intersection of ecological thinking, somatic experience and narrative art, inviting listening and resonance inside and out. Founder and director of Estudio Nuboso, a platform for art and ecology based in Panama. She recently launched the SUELO Field Guide - a methodology to help us reconnect with the places we inhabit, and hosts a podcast called Tejiendo Corredores~Weaving Corridors where she explores the notion of nature-culture corridors of planetary solidarity. Her artworks have been shown at the XIII Bienal de La Habana, Cuba (2019); the X Bienal Centroamericana in Costa Rica (2016); the Bienal de Artes Visuales del Istmo Centroamericano (Bavic9) in Guatemala (2014); and in group exhibitions in Panama, Central and South America, and Europe. She is part of the MAC - Panama Contemporary Art Museum collection. As a facilitator, she works with museums, universities, scientific and cultural institutions as well as environmental NGOs and individuals around the world.
